Local 1991 and Jackson Health System are working together to keep employees and patients healthy during flu season .

Local 1991 members are pitching in to educate coworkers and volunteering to administer the flu shot to coworkers. This effort is one of our Labor Management Partnership initiatives.

The goal is to more than double last year's participation rate of employees receiving the flu vaccine.



Where can I get the shot?

- **On your unit.** About 140 of your co-workers volunteered to improve access to the vaccine. Employees participating in the peer-to-peer program can administer flu vaccinations to coworkers in their units to make sure everyone can get vaccinated.
- **In the Employee Health Office** (11th floor, Jackson Towers).
- The shot will also be available at a number of events throughout the next month. See schedule for times and locations.

“If I can do something that may prevent one patient from getting the flu, I will,” said long-time JMHEmergency Department physician Dr. David Woolsey. “I am going to get vaccinated. And I tell everyone, ‘Take the shot!’”
